<p>2nd XI Captain Report A largely dismal season for the 2nd team who only challenged for promotion after a run of wins that was probably an effect of playing the weakest sides one after another. The dismal season can be explained as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No less than 3 to 5 team changes per week and constant scratching around for players throughout the season. As such there was not enough chance to have people cement position in a regular batting line up or bowling attack and make my task of the lineup easier on a regular basis. • A successful base for a team would have been having a somewhat regular: keeper, opening bowler partnership, and a contributive batting lineup. • We did not have a regular keeper • Our opening bowlers took wickets but not consistently - the added problem that they did not have the presence of mind to tactically fall back to a run saving mode. 	

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Our batting line up did not provide enough runs and was regularly down 3-5 wickets in the first 10 to 20 overs. • Overall I cannot say that there was enough team performance in the batting department to contribute towards building scores or making some value of those 3 to 5 wickets. • Also in spite of the insistence of certain players to play in the 2s, and insist on batting high or bowling high, there were no individually brilliant performers that we could count on regularly to help win games. • My most meorable game was away vs Harting where in the field we had a brilliant bowling partnership with run saving mode, and a good team fielding performance. At the end of the game for the first time I felt that everyone who played cared that we had lost. • Lots of luck to next year's captain
